Effective May 18, 2021, USEF released a new edition of the **USEF COVID-19 Action Plan for Licensed Competitions**. Going forward, competitions must operate in accordance with state and local requirements.

“Governor Greg Abbott has issued an Executive Order (GA-34), on March 10, 2021, lifting the mask mandate in Texas and increasing capacity of business and facilities in the state to 100 percent. This executive order rescinded most of the Governor’s earlier Executive Orders related to COVID-19. Effective Wednesday, March 10, 2021, all businesses of any type may open to 100% capacity. Additionally, this order ends the statewide mask mandate in Texas. Businesses may still limit capacity or implement additional safety protocols at their own discretion.” Source: [Coronavirus \(COVID-19\) – City of Bryan, Texas \(bryantx.gov\)](#)

On May 13, 2021, the CDC announced that anyone who is fully vaccinated against COVID-19 can participate in indoor and outdoor activities, large or small, without wearing a face covering/mask or physically distancing. Personal responsibility is essential, as competition organizers are not required to verify vaccination status.

Per USEF, all participants, including licensed officials and volunteers will be required to provide emergency contact information and will execute a ‘Waiver and Release of Liability, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement’ required by the USEF, as a condition of participation. On or before September 1st, our club’s COVID-19 Best Practices and Requirements for our Show will be posted on our website **www.gulfcoastarabians.com** under the tab ‘COVID-19’.

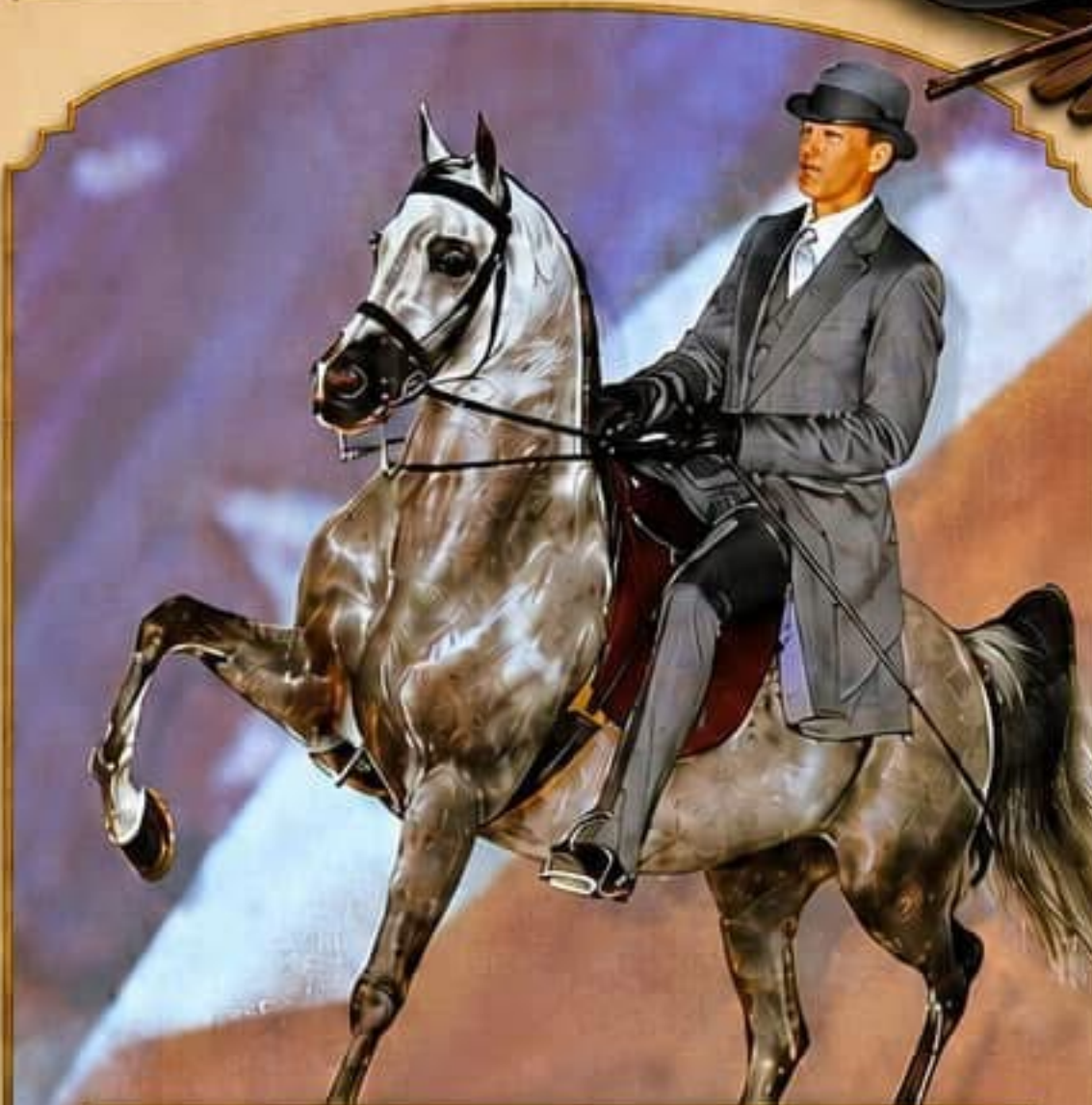

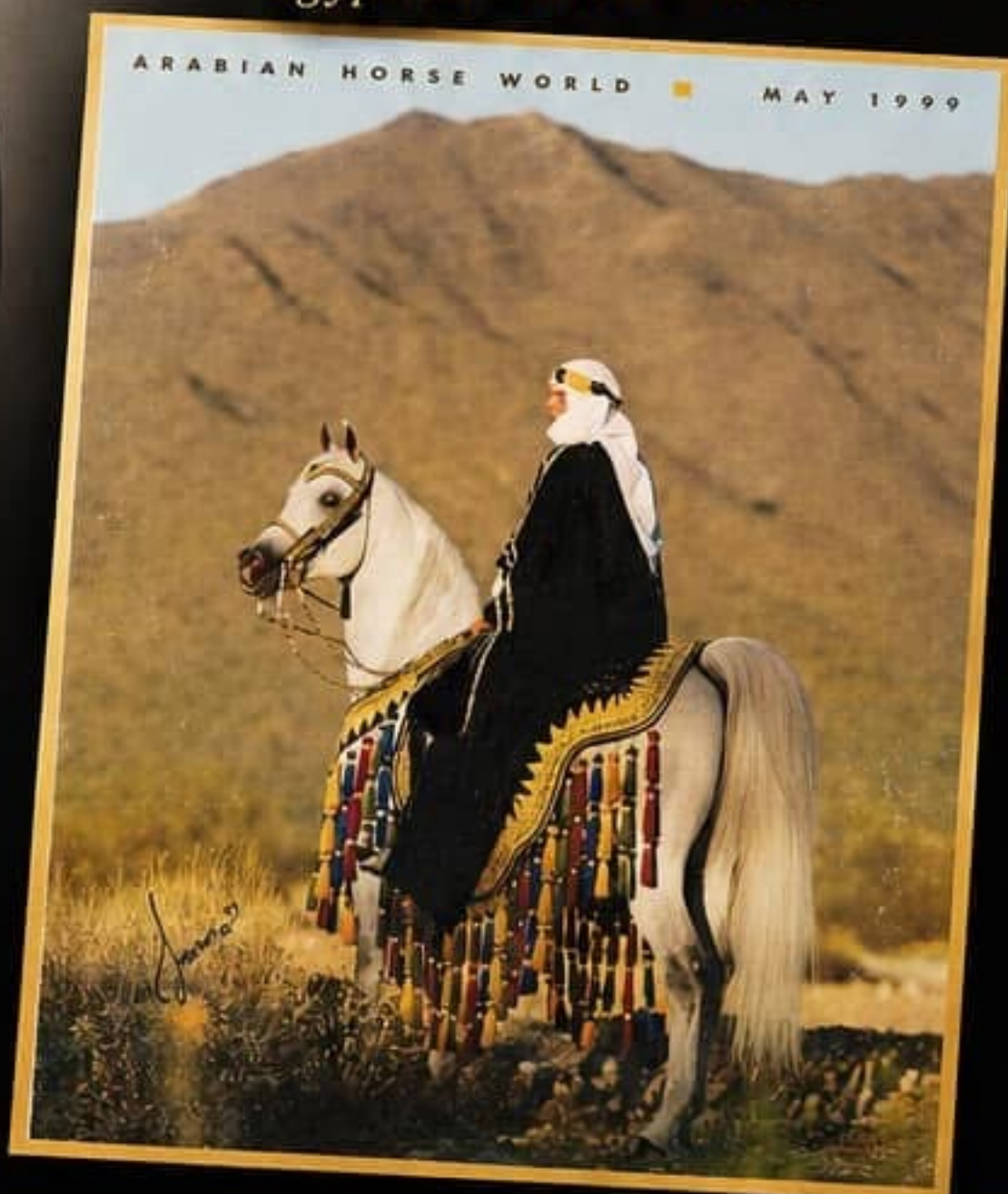

Individuals with non-competing horses must complete and sign an **“USEF WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT”** form.

NOTE: If you plan to enter ONLY the Egyptian classes you DO NOT have to pay AHA or USEF mandatory fees or be a member. However, if you decide to enter a regular show class with an AHA class number, you will need to be a member and pay the mandatory AHA and USEF fees. You are required to fill out an Entry Form and Waiver.

Saturday Evening Feature: The Spectacular Egyptian Stallion Presentation

As part of Saturday evening's Egyptian Classic, we invite you to enjoy the Spectacular Egyptian Stallion Presentation. This special presentation will be held in the Main Ring immediately following the Straight Egyptian Halter Classes and prior to the Heritage Egyptian Halter Classes.

Participation is limited to the first ten (10) Egyptian stallions entered. Additional Egyptian stallions will be placed on a waiting list. If the presentation does not fill, non-Egyptian stallions may be considered to fill the remaining presentation spots. **No minors may handle presentation stallions in the warm-up area or in the arena.**

Presentation Guidelines

- Each presentation should be approximately 2–3 minutes in length, with one stallion in the arena at a time.
- Participants are to provide their own music and a written transcript to be read during the presentation.
- Music may also be provided to Mr. Robert Cass, Announcer, for download prior to arriving at the show.
- Please email your written transcript to Patty Liarakos, Show Secretary, no later than **September 11, 2026**.
- **Bagging will not be permitted in the warm-up area or in the arena.**

All participating Spectacular Egyptian Stallions will be featured in the official show program, provided your advertisement is submitted to Dot Glesmann at promotions.GCAHC@gmail.com no later than **September 16, 2026**.

Programs will be available throughout the show and distributed to exhibitors, visitors, and spectators.

How to Reserve Your Spot – Non-Showing Stallions

Complete an entry form with the stallion's name and, if known, the person who will be handling the horse.

Complete the owner's information (name, complete address, phone number, and email address), or the information for the person responsible for the horse during the show.

Sign all three required signature lines on the back of the entry form (Owner, Trainer, and Rider).

Indicate your stall preference (Day Stall or Weekend Stall).

Enter the Stallion Presentation fee of \$75. Mail your completed entry form, payment in full, and a copy of the stallion's current Coggins to Patty Liarakos, Show Secretary (address listed on the entry form). You may also include your written transcript if it is ready.

How to Reserve Your Spot – Showing Stallions

Complete all of the above information, along with the Horse, Owner, Rider, and Trainer sections.

Include your class numbers and all applicable fees. If your stallion is showing in the Main Ring, membership is required for all individuals listed on the entry form.

Following the Presentation

Following the presentation, guests are invited to visit the participating stallions in the barns. A map showing the location of each presentation stallion will be available in the Show Office and on the tables in the arena.

Offering Incentive for Pre- Entries

To encourage pre-entries, cancelations prior to Wed. September 9th will be refunded, regardless of the reason. However, you must have your entries in prior to August 28th to be eligible for a full refund.

After August 28, 2026 entries will be charged a post entry fee of \$40 per horse. Entry of a horse on or after September 11th will be charged \$50 per horse post entry fee.



BUY-A-CLASS

Thirty (30) buy-a-class (BAC) slots are available for purchase. Exceptions: Cross Rail, Cutting Horse, Dressage, Jumping, Sport Horse, Working Cow Horse, and Reined Cow Horse. AGE SPLITS may be purchased in any division listed on our Class Schedule.

\$75 Buy-A-Class fee in addition to the regular class entry fee. IF the Buy-A-Class has four or more entries the Buy-A-Class fee will be refunded. The person buying the class will be

announced as the class sponsor.

Once a class has been “bought,” other exhibitors may enter for the normal class fee. Buy-A-Classes purchased prior to the start of our show will be posted on our Facebook page and website <http://www.gulfcoastarabians.com/> afterwards in the Show Office. BACs are sold on a first come basis, however, no one individual, trainer, or barn may buy more than three (3) classes, unless all classes are not sold by August 29, 2026. Once the limit of 30 BAC is reached, the purchaser is responsible for any additional fees charged by AHA and USEF.

If classes are bought at the show, Show Management will determine placement, and the fee will be \$100 for regular classes. You must purchase at least one day in advance. Championship Buy-A-Classes will not be eligible for prize money or prizes, only ribbon.

LIMITS ON NUMBER OF GOES

- Reining classes are limited to a total of 30 goes.
- Ranch Riding classes are limited to 60 goes.
- Trail classes are limited to 70 goes.

For classes that have an order of go, they must be entered before the beginning of the session proceeding them. For example, if the class with an order of go is Sunday morning, you must enter before the Saturday evening session starts. This allows our Show Secretary time to post the order of go in a timely manner.

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in this Competition, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, junior exhibitor, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. **I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN, AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.**

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ENTRY INFORMATION Pre-Entries

At the show, you MUST pre-enter (and scratch) classes before the end of the prior session. For the Friday morning session, the entry deadline is 7:30AM. **Failure to scratch fee is \$15.00 per class.** Exception: schooling classes are ride-through-the-gate classes and do not have to be pre-entered. For classes that have an order of go, they must be entered before the beginning of the session proceeding them. For example, if the class with an order of go is Sun. morning, they must enter before the beginning of Sat. evening session. To exhibit in a class that was not entered or if a horse or rider is not going to show in a class that was entered, complete the add/scratch form in the show office. Classes scratched prior to the end of the deadline will be processed at no charge, and the entry will receive a full refund for the class fee. Classes scratched after the deadline must scratch at the gate before the

gate opens for that class to avoid the **"Failure to Scratch" fee of \$15 per class.**

Entries

Entries will not be accepted unless accompanied by a negotiable, signed valid check or money order for the total amount. If received without payment, they will become post entries and the post entry fee will apply. All entries must have cards and papers current. You do not need to send them with your entries. They will be verified online by the Secretary. AHA Registration Number, USEF Horse Identification Number, AHA and USEF membership numbers must be written on the entry form. Entry form must be signed on front & back in three places and a minor release signed if applicable.. **An incomplete entry form will be charged a \$20 fee.**

Health Certificate, Negative Coggins & Required Vaccinations

Texas horses required documentation, to be presented at the show office upon arrival, is a (1) Negative Equine Infectious Anemia (EIA) Test (Coggins) within the last 12 months and (2) documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhino pneumonitis) vaccination within six months prior to entering the facility (see USEF GR845). These time restrictions must not expire while the horse is on the grounds. There will be no exception to any health requirement. All animals must be in accordance with the current rules of the Texas Animal Health Commission (TACH 512-719-0777). Health requirements are subject to change by TAHC.

Out-of-state exhibitors' horses must be aware of and follow the TAHC requirements for entering the state (www.tahc.state.tx.us/regs/entry.html). Per Texas law, any out-of-state horse entering the grounds must be accompanied by a health certificate issued within 45 days of the show as well as a negative Coggins issued within 12 months. These must be presented at the Show Office prior to receiving numbers. All horses are subject to inspection by the show veterinarian.

Entry Closing Information / Post Entries

Entries close on August 28, 2026. Post entries will be accepted. Entries postmarked after August 28, 2026 will be considered post entries and will be assessed an additional \$40 per horse. A United States Postal Service postmark will take precedence over postmarks from private meters, etc. Entry forms of a horse submitted on or after September 11th will be charged a \$50 per horse post entry fee. Post entry fees do not apply to classes added during the show.

Stall Information

We should have plenty of stalls, to reserve stalls, indicate the number of stalls and dollar amount on the Entry Form, please get your requests in early. Mail the completed entry form to our Show Secretary. No requests for adjoining stalls from different owners will be honored unless all entry forms are mailed together. Stalls are covered, of sturdy construction with stall doors, in good condition and safe for horses.

For your convenience, the stall chart will be posted outside the show office. **All horses must move out on Sunday prior to 10PM.**

Farm/Exhibitor Stall Area Clean-up Fee

YOU MUST pick up all your trash from your stalls, remove boards, screws, nails, tarps, empty cans, etc. **If the facility has to clean-up your stall area, you will be billed the clean-up fee they charge our club (minimum charge is \$100 per stall area), maximum \$1000.**

Shavings, Hay & Grain

Shavings must be purchased from our Show Office (\$13 per 3.5 cu. ft. compressed bag) – NO SHAVINGS OR STRAW MAY BE BROUGHT ON SITE. Hay and grain will not be available.

Show Office

Refunds

To encourage pre-entries, cancelations prior to Friday, August 28th will be refunded, regardless of the reason. For cancelations on or after September 11th, all fees will be refunded less \$30 per horse with presentation of a veterinarian certificate showing cause to withdraw. Otherwise, refunds will not be given on or after September 11th.

Cancellation of Classes due to Emergencies

If a class, or a series of classes, or all or part of the competition is cancelled due to an accident, storm, or other emergency after the start of the show (defined as initial Move-In Day), no refund of entry fees will be made.

GENERAL INFORMATION Farrier,

Veterinarian, & First Aid

A veterinarian will be on call; phone number will be posted at the show office and is in the list at the front of this prize list. The use of other veterinarians will be allowed, but they must check in with the show manager prior to treatment, or in the case of an emergency, after treatment. In the event of an acute and serious injury to or illness of a horse on competition grounds when the owner or trainer of the horse or agent of the owner is not present, after reasonable effort to contact that individual has been made, competition management, in consultation with a licensed equine veterinarian, may authorize the provision of emergency veterinary treatment of the horse. If competition management so authorizes treatment under the provisions of this rule, competition management and veterinarian are not liable for any resulting costs, damages, losses, claims, or actions arising directly or indirectly from the treatment of the horse.

Farrier

A farrier will be on-site. His phone number will be posted at the show office. We ask that you use the services of the show farrier. All other farriers must check in with the show manager prior to seeing any customers, get permission to work on the show grounds, and pay a vendor fee.

A licensed EMT will be on the show grounds during each session of the show, for first aid needs. In addition, if an ambulance, is required, it will be summoned by a call to 911 by Show Management. Show Management does have an Emergency Preparedness Plan for this show.

Judges

In the event of illness or failure of a judge or any other official to attend this show or to perform his duties, the show committee reserves the right to substitute an official for the one officially designated in the prize list, according to USEF rules.

Insufficient Funds and Returned Check Charge Checks returned to the GCAHC marked "insufficient funds" for any reason will be assessed an additional \$50 fee per check. If restitution is not made immediately upon first verbal or written notification, the GCAHC will take all appropriate actions with USEF and AHA and payer will be barred from taking part in any USEF, AHA, or GCAHC recognized show until final settlement. GCAHC reserves the right to require certified funds.

Indebtedness to Show

Any exhibitor who fails to settle indebtedness to the Show Veterinarian or Farrier for services during the show before leaving the show grounds will be barred from future GCAHC shows until debt is paid in full; and also reported to USEF. In the case of indebtedness, the GCAHC will fully pursue action of Texas law.

DOGS

USEF GR1301.6 - Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be held on a leash or otherwise restrained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses, or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors.

No dogs will be allowed in the show arenas. A Steward may issue a USEF Yellow Warning card offense (refer to USEF GR1037 & GR1301.6), if rules and regulations are not adhered to.

Facility Information & Requirements

No extension cords are allowed on the ground or buried. **No duct tape is to be used on any painted surface.** The facility does not allow cooking in the barns. No glass containers are allowed inside the Arena, Pavilion, or any part of the Complex grounds.

The Brazos County Expo facility has paved roads that surround all four sides of its complex and 1,548 parking spaces allow efficient flow of traffic into and out of the Complex. The **South Arena** will be divided to create two arenas (one to be used for warm-up prior to each class and the other as our Show

Arena). The South Arena is 140' by 200', the North Arena is 130' by 241' covered; all footing is sand and clay. A separate covered Warm-up Arena and huge outdoor arena will be available for working horses. The South Arena will be available for warm-up on Thursday. The Brazos County Expo will operate concessions during show hours.

Sharps Containers:

Sharps containers are placed prominently in each barn for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments. These containers when full will be disposed of properly. Competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.

Questions, Disputes, & Protests

All protests and questions not covered by these rules shall be decided by the Show Committee, whose decision shall be final. Disputes should be presented to the Show Chairman prior to filing a formal protest under the provisions of USEF GR603. Any rider, driver, handler, exhibitor, owner, agent, trainer, or the parents of a junior exhibitor may file a protest with the Show

Committee or The Federation Hearing Committee alleging a violation of any USEF rule(s). The protest must be in writing, signed by the protester, addressed to the secretary of the competition at which the alleged violation occurred, or to the Hearing Committee, and accompanied by a deposit of \$200 if made by an USEF member or the parent of a junior exhibitor member or \$300 if made by a non-member; said deposit will be refunded in the event the protest is upheld, and received by the steward, a member of the Show Committee, the competition manager or the competition secretary within 48 hours of the alleged violation, or if made directly to the Hearing Committee, it must be received at the USEF office by the fifth business day following the last recognized day of the competition.

Motorized Vehicle Statement

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles if they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses, or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to Segway's, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Conduct of Show Participants

This show shall be conducted in accordance with the rules of the United States Equestrian Federation [USEF], and the Arabian Horse Association. The official rulebooks of each of these organizations will prevail for this show; any changes or corrections of these rules automatically become part of this book.

In accordance with USEF GR839.5 Cruelty to and Abuse of a Horse: Any action(s) against a horse by a competitor or an exhibitor, which are deemed excessive by a judge, Federation steward, technical delegate, or competition veterinarian, in the competition ring or anywhere on the competition grounds may be punished by official warning, elimination, or other sanctions which may be deemed appropriate by the Show Committee. Such action(s) could include but are not limited to excessive use of the whip, spurs, or bamboo poles.

INDEMNITY AND RESPONSIBILITY

All entries are accepted with the understanding that neither, Brazos County Expo Complex, THE GULF COAST ARABIAN HORSE CLUB, the Show Committee, nor any Show Official will be held responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to any horse exhibited or any article of any kind. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the show committee but solely at the risk of the exhibitor, who will be responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, and the exhibitor shall indemnify the above-mentioned parties against all loss, damages and liability thus occasioned, including but not limited to all legal costs, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. THE SUBMITTING OF AN ENTRY FORM TO THE SHOW SHALL CONSTITUTE AN ACCEPTANCE BY EACH PERSON SIGNING SAME OF THE PROVISIONS HEREIN SET FORTH.

WARNING – Under Texas Law (Chapter 87, Civil Practice and Remedies Code), a farm animal professional is not liable for an Injury to or the death of a participant in farm animal activities resulting from the inherent risks of farm animal activities.

RULES & REGULATIONS

SafeSport Training USEF GR1303 -

All USEF members 18-years-old and older, with a Competing Membership, must complete SafeSport Training to be eligible to participate in USEF activities. The required SafeSport Training needs to be completed **annually**. The courses are assigned on a four-year schedule, starting with the full Safe Sport Training (*approximately 90 minutes*), followed by three years of Safe Sport Refresher Trainings (*approximately 30 minutes*). 'Take the Safe Sport Training or Refresher SafeSport Training at USEF.org by logging into your member dashboard.

Safe Sport Reminder:

All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must

adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

Rule Violations -

USEF GR1037 - When a Steward or Technical Delegate becomes aware of a potential violation of Federation rules, without waiting for a protest, he shall investigate and notify the appropriate individual or official, and, if not rectified, issue a yellow warning card (GR1037), and/or file a charge (GR604). At the conclusion of the investigation, if a Steward or Technical Delegate determines a charge may not be appropriate, all information surrounding the potential violation must be included in the Report.

Class Specifications

This show will be conducted within rules of the United States Equestrian Federation (USEF) and the Arabian Horse Association (AHA). "EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREIN."

Breeding/Gelding In-Hand – "In the Ring Procedures"

Comparative judging using the "in the ring procedures" will be used. Reasons will not be given by the judges. Whips are to be no longer than 6' including snapper/lash/appendage. Small appendages (no more than 12 inches in length) of ribbon, plastic, etc. are permitted (USEF AR114.2). NO BAGGING will be permitted in the warm up area nor in the arena/

Breeding/ Geldings In-Hand Championships

USEF AR118 Yearlings are now eligible to win the Championship in either a Junior Championship or Grand Show Championship class. You cannot show filly & colt weanlings (purebred or HA/AA) in our Championship classes. Eligible first and second place horses may compete in the designated Halter/Breeding Championship class. The Championship title shall be awarded to an eligible first place horse. The second-place horse to the named champion may compete with the balance of first place horses for the Reserve Championship title. Walking horses quietly on the rail is optional at the judge's discretion.

Performance Halter

Score Sheets will be used for Performance Halter. Performance Halter CAN NOT be split by ages (USEF AR 123.2) Exception - "Prospect" class for horses 2 & under may be held at the discretion of show management. Horses must be 3 & over and be entered in a performance (under saddle or driving) class at the same show – or have competed in an Endurance of Competitive Trail Ride.

Egyptian and Heritage Egyptian Classes

Straight Egyptian horse is listed in the AHA Datasource database, <https://www.arabianhorses.org/datasource/> as Straight Egyptian. The Straight Egyptian is the blending of strains of pure, undisputed, desert heritage. Heritage Egyptian horse has at least one grandparent listed in the AHA Datasource as Straight Egyptian but is not considered 100% Egyptian. In the Country English Pleasure Futurity and the English Pleasure Futurity horses will be shown in a snaffle defined as a smooth, rounded snaffle bit that is at least 3/8" in diameter as measured 1/2" from the ring. The snaffle will be either single or double jointed. The rings may be 2" to 4" diameter and may be loose ring, egg-butt or dee ring (half cheeks permitted). Should a double-jointed snaffle be used, the center piece must be smooth, round or flat. The snaffle bit may be wrapped with Guardtex, Latex, Sealtex or similar materials.

Hunter Pleasure Classes

For Hunter Pleasure classes, a Snaffle Bit is defined as a snaffle bit of at least 3/8" diameter as measured 1/2" from the ring. The snaffle bit must have a round, egg butt or "D" shaped ring with no attachments to the headstall or reins through a hook (except for keepers for a full cheek snaffle). Full cheek (with or without keepers), French and Dr. Bristol snaffle bits are permitted. If a curb strap is used, it must be attached below the reins (Maturity class specifications may differ from Futurity requirements, refer to PERF 110 and USEF Rule Book)

Headers and Leadline (Leadline 2-6)

This class is open to riders who are at least two (2) years of age and have not reached their seventh (7th) birthday as of December 1. Leaders must be at least fourteen (14) years of age. The safety of all exhibitors must be of primary consideration when conducting these classes. Any action by any exhibitor, leader or horse that endangers that exhibitor, or any other exhibitor or leader must be penalized and will be considered as cause for elimination. Safety is of the utmost importance in tack and attire: a) saddle must fit rider; b) rider's feet must be engaged in the stirrups/irons; c) saddles may be equipped with hooded stirrups or breakaway irons; d) leading rein may be attached to a cavesson or a halter placed under or over the bridle; e) safety helmets, with chin straps, may be used by any rider, regardless of style of tack and/or attire; f) boots, long pants and long sleeve shirts are required. **Stallions are prohibited.** This class will not be placed, and similar awards will be presented to all exhibitors.

Walk-Trot 10 & Under Classes:

Open to riders 10 years old and under. A rider must have never been judged in a class at a recognized or non-recognized competition that required a lope or canter. Stallions are prohibited. Riders are not allowed to cross-enter any other classes except Breeding/In-Hand, Showmanship, or other Walk-Trot classes. Classes for Walk/Trot 10 & Under Ranch Riding Rail Pleasure and Trail goes into effect Dec. 1, 2022.

General Performance Classes –

USEF AR125.4

When the judge calls for the lineup, exhibitors must continue in the same direction the class is working when bringing their entries to the lineup. Horses must come to the lineup at the gait requested. Judges must penalize entries that do not comply.

In the line up, horses must stand quietly and may be asked to back individually or as a group returning to the line up at a walk with no additional testing. In driving classes requiring a rein back in the line up, the over check or side check may be adjusted by the header but must remain fastened until the reinback has been completed.

Western Pleasure Qualifying Gaits –

Back: In the lineup, horses may be asked to back in a straight line with no additional testing, returning to the lineup at a walk. Horses may be asked to back on the rail. This rule change applies to: OPEN, AMATEUR, LADIES, GENTLEMEN and JUNIOR HORSE, see USEF AR146.1-4 - Western Pleasure Specifications.

General – Western or English Trail Horse -

USEF AR224.9 & 10 -

9. Trail Horse - Under Saddle

a. Trail classes may be offered for Western or English, but the two styles are not to be combined into one class at any time as there are distinct differences.

b. There is no rail work. The course must be designed to require each horse to show all three (3) gaits, (walk, jog/ trot at least thirty (30) feet, lope/canter right and left lead) somewhere between and/or over obstacles as part of its work, and quality of movement and cadence should be considered as part of the obstacle score. Unnecessary delays while approaching or negotiating an obstacle shall be penalized.

c. ASTM Helmets are required for all English Trail classes.

10. Trail Horse - In-hand

a. In-hand trail classes may be offered for Western and English styles which may be combined.

b. Judges should consider the overall appearance of the horse, conditioning, grooming and the equipment in the overall score. Also, to be considered is the correctness of the horse while being led. For safety reasons, those handlers continuously holding the chain on the lead, tightly coiling the lead shank around the

hand, or dragging the lead shank must be penalized.

c. There is no rail work. To include a walk and jog/trot of suitable duration to determine the way of going.

Management is encouraged to design courses that can be negotiated in ninety (90) seconds.

See AR236 for class requirements. BOD 9/16/19

Protective Headgear

Affirmation of the United States Equestrian Federation Helmet/Vest Rule – GR801.4 Dress

Any exhibitor may wear protective headgear (ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) and/or a protective safety vest, specifically designed for use in equestrian sport in any division or class without penalty from the judge. The Federation recommends that the vest meet or surpass the current ASTM standard or be certified by the Safety Equipment Institute.

Except as may otherwise be mandated by local law riders in all Working Hunter, Jumper, Hunter Hack, English Trail, and all Hunt Seat Equitation classes not to jump or over obstacles and when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds, must wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. Refer to USEF AR111.2 and USEF GR801.7.



Walk/Jog Trail Class Requirements – USEF AR233.3 & 233.4

3. Serpentine – Walk Around – No more than 5 consecutive pylons. a. Western Trail Walk/Jog-minimum 6 feet apart (base to base). Guardrails, if used, should be 3 to 4 feet to either side of the pylons. b. English Trail Walk/Trot-minimum 8 feet apart (base to base). Guardrails, if used, should be 4 to 5 feet to either side of the pylons.

4. Serpentine – Jog Around – No more than 5 consecutive pylons a. Western Trail Walk/Jog-minimum of 10 feet apart (base to base). Guardrails, if used, should be 8 to 10 feet on either side of pylons. b. English Trail Walk/Trot-minimum of 12 feet apart (base to base). Guardrails, if used, should be 10 to 12 feet on either side of pylons.

Ranch Horse Rail Pleasure

The new Ranch Horse Walk/Trot classes will not go into effect until Dec. 1, 2022. If a show holds any of these classes, they must be an Exhibition class and

will NOT be recorded with AHA. Classes for Walk/Trot 10 & Under and Walk/Trot 11 & Over Ranch Riding Rail Pleasure and Trail goes into effect Dec. 1, 2022.

AHA Medal Classes

AHA Medal Class Requirements – **USEF AR246.20.e** - e. AHA Western Horsemanship Medal class 1. In addition to the rail work, all contestants are required to perform a minimum of four tests from AR244 Western Horsemanship. **13 & Under: Tests 1-7 and 10; 14-18, 18 & Under and 19 & Over: Tests 1-10.**

AHA Medal Class Specifications are now located in the USEF Rulebook. Please refer to the Arabian Division Chapter for rules & class specs

Schooling Classes

- Training devices allowed
- Show attire not required
- No placings or points
- Each rider must have a back number
- **Entry fee \$10**
- Ride through the gate
- No scratch or add fees will be charged

Additionally, for horses not otherwise entered or exhibiting in the show:

- An entry form & Waiver must be completed & signed
- Office fee and grounds/stall fee will be charged
- Post entry fee will not be charged
- USEF and AHA Membership is not required
- Health requirements apply

Class Information Amateur Exhibitor

Every rider or driver no longer eligible to compete as a junior exhibitor but wishing to participate in amateur classes must have or apply for USEF Membership.

Junior Exhibitor

Junior exhibitors shall not have reached their 19th birthday prior to 12/1/2025. For Horse Show purposes, the age of the junior exhibitor on December 1 of the show year shall be maintained throughout the entire year. Junior exhibitors may enter Ladies & Gentlemen classes.

Combined Ownership

USEF GR142, in the Arabian Division, combined ownership is permitted in Owner's or Amateur Owner's classes, per AR110. Leased horses are not eligible. (Contracts of Sale or Bill of Sale will not be accepted in Owner's Classes).

AR110.4 - Two distinct non-family owners may co-own a horse and show that horse in Junior Owner or Amateur Owner's classes except that no family member of a professional may enter into this relationship. Non-family owners are defined as two distinct individuals who are not related as family as defined by U.S. or Canada Equestrian. Please USEF AR110.4.e for complete requirements and limitations.

Check-in and Calls for Classes

Check-in with the Paddock Master is required, prior to going in your class. The public address system will be used to make barn calls if possible; however, exhibitors are responsible for seeing that entries reach the gate on time and should not rely on the P.A. system.

Tack Changes

Time for tack changes must be reported to the Paddock Manager prior to the start of a session, to permit proper notification to ring officials. A maximum three-minute hold will be allowed. Exhibitor requesting hold must notify gate promptly when tack change has been completed so class can enter ring without unnecessary delay.

Admission to the Arena

No person will be permitted to enter the arena except participants in the class, judges and their assistants, show photographer and assistant, show officials and staff. Attendants will not be permitted in the arena until summoned by the judge.

Two Minute Rule

When horses are competing collectively, if a first horse does not enter the in-gate ready to participate within one minute from when the class is called into the ring, a warning is issued.

a. Exhibitors will then have one additional minute to start the steady stream of horses into the in-gate.

b. If no horses have entered the gate at the conclusion of the additional one minute, the gate shall be closed, and the class is deemed concluded.

c. Once the first horse has entered the in-gate, a steady stream of horses must be maintained.

d. Should the steady stream be broken after the two minutes have elapsed, the gate shall be closed, and judging will commence.

e. A steady stream is defined as a constant flow of horses moving forward through the in-gate with a reasonable and safe distance between them (i.e., two to four horse or horse and buggy lengths in between).

f. Show Management in conjunction with the Steward may deviate from this procedure as circumstances warrant.

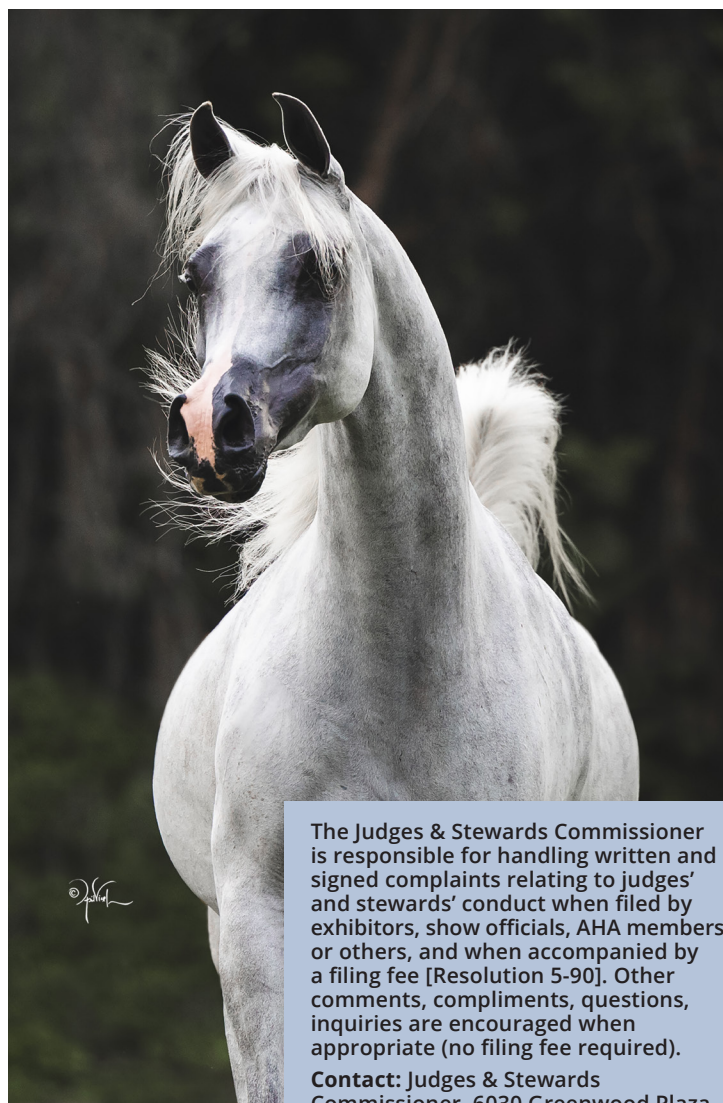

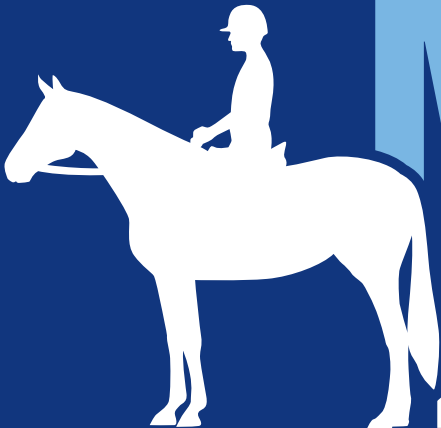

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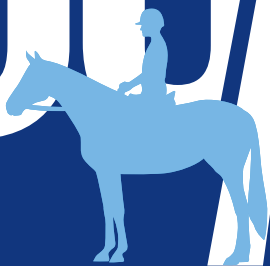

AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT



EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR.

WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP.

SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS.

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes
